- 3. Attend scheduled membership meetings.
- 4. Pay dues of \$35.00 per month plus 10% of sales and a 5% charge on credit card sales.
- 5. Have every item unrelated to their originally approved works re -juried and accepted by a membership vote.
- 6. Applicants who join after October 1 through December 31 **MUST** pay six months **non-refundable** dues in advance before their work is displayed.

BENEFITS

- 1. We have an excellent location at 25-27 North Broad Street in Historic Downtown Norwich.
- 2. Members set their own prices and retain 90% of each sale.
- 3. MIC pays all sales taxes and members receive his/her receipts and check for that month at the beginning of the next month.
